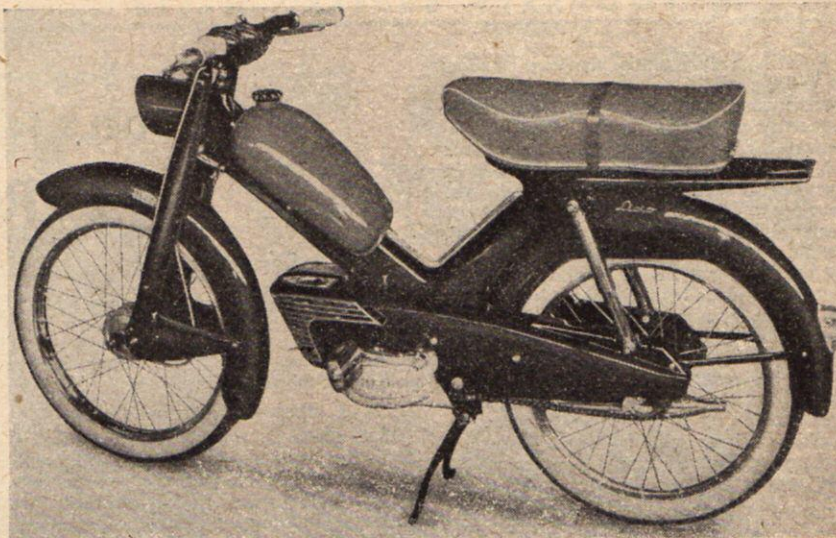

CURRYS MARKET MO-PEd

ANNOUNCED in our issue dated February 7, the "streamlined" German Achilles "Lido" mo-ped is to be listed at 75 guineas. Claimed to be capable of covering 200 m.p.g., and fitted with a 49 c.c. Sachs two-stroke engine, the model was introduced at a reception held last Thursday at Browns Hotel, W.1, by Currys, the well-known cycle and accessory dealers who are importing the machine.
