The highest-priced machines on the Coventry Eagle stands will be the N.C.U. models, named with the approval of the National Cyclists' Union. The frames are built up with Reynolds high manganese aircraft steel tubes, with all the usual refinements associated with high-class machines, including two of the renowned Monitor super-cam brakes. Both the ladies' and gent.'s models are priced at £6 15s., and at £7 15s. a super model will be on view, built up with Chater Lea fittings, Resilion A rear brake and Bluemels No-Weight mudguards.

An attractive range of lower-priced club and tourist models will also be prominently displayed, including the Classic Safety Tourist at £6 9s. 6d., embodying two hub brakes, gear-case, and North-road upturned bars. Both this and all Coventry Eagle machines for the coming year have a large-capacity touring bag included with the equipment.

Moderate-priced touring tandems will command a lot of attention, for Model 52 has an attractive specification, yet only costs £12 12s., while Model 56, at £15 19s. 6d., has a double cross-tube frame, and either Sturmey Archer K.T., Cyclo, or Trivelox three-speed gears and a built-in dynamo lighting set.
