


## The Viberti Arrive

The machines that created such a sensation at the Milan Show are being handled in Britain by Dot Cycle and Motor Manufacturing Co. Ltd., Arundel Street and Ellesmere Street Works. Manchester 15. under the name Dot-Vivi.

The three models are the moped (Top picture), Racer (Centre) and Scooterette and all have the Vittoria 48 c.c. engine, that of the Racer being tuned to produce 2.6 b.h.p. Wheels are 24in. x 2in. with 4in. internal expanding brakes. Bottom link front forks are employed and rear suspension is by swinging arm with hydraulic shock absorbers. There is 18-watt direct lighting from the flywheel. Finish is in two colours, the Racer being red and green and the other fawn and grey.

Prices are: Mo-ped - 69 gns., Racer - 79 gns., and Scooterette 84 gns., tax included.
