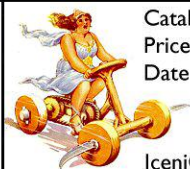

MORE FOREIGN MACHINES

TO be known in this country under the name of "Leopard," several models of the range produced in Germany by Pantherwerke A.G., of Brunswick, are now being imported by Christie and Sadler, Ltd., 68 Finsbury Pavement, Moorgate, London, E.C.2. Amongst the models are three mo-peds which are called the "Bobby 3, 5 and 6" to distinguish them; a 175 c.c. two-stroke with full-width hubs, pivoting fork rear suspension and fully enclosed rear chain. Three scooters of 50 c.c., 175 c.c. and 250 c.c., this latter has a press-button gear change, are to be imported shortly. The mo-peds sell at £71 8s., £78 15s. and £89 5s. inc. P.T. for the models 3, 5 and 6 respectively, the price of the 175 is not finally fixed but is expected to be around £140.
