The firm exhibit a cover forwarded by a customer which has covered some four thousand miles, and which, in the letter accompanying it, the owner requests the firm to re-vulcanise. This may be accepted as a fair criterion of the condition in which the cover is. The firm have a 1¼in. wired tyre for the trade ready to be placed forthwith on the market. Their detachable flanged rim is still to the fore, and forms a leading line on the stand.
