



GUARDS [pat. applied]


PRICE 3/- PER SET

These guards are designed to protect the rider's legs from spray in wet weather. When fitted they must be butting against the side of the crankcase as illustrated. Note: There should be no gap between the front half of the mudguard and the underside of the crankcase.

TYRE GAUGE

This has been designed to enable you to check the clearance between the Driving Roller and the Tyre.


Note: The tyre
must be pumped up
HARD before checking and the Tyre
Gauge must JUST
pass between the
Roller and the Tyre.



PLUG GAUGE

This has been made for you to check the Points gap in the Sparking Plug.

Note: The Plug should be cleaned and the Gauge should only JUST pass through.



MAG GAUGE


This will enable you to check the gap between the Contact Breaker Points in the Magneto.

Note: The Points MUST be in their fully open position before checking (see Instruction Book).



USES FOR THE

I. A blocked jet can usually be cleared by simply inserting the Jet gauge into it without removing the Jet.


Note: The Petrol Tap should be switched off before removing the jet plug.






2. Cleaning the Jet after removal.

Note: Care should be taken not to scratch or damage it. The gauge MUST be passed through the jet very lightly.



3. Cleaning the Float Chamber Top. It is only necessary to pass the gauge gently through the hole. Thoroughly wash with petrol before refitting.

FITTING INSTRUCTIONS —

Slacken off the wheel spindle nut A. Push the guard fully home on to the spindle, preferably behind the Motor Stay Rod (as illustrated). If preferred, the guard can be fitted on the outside of the Motor Stay Rod. True the rear wheel and tighten the spindle nut.
