

IMPORTANT.

No German material of any kind is used in the manufacture of our Cycles, nor any material which is of inferior quality; consequently we do not keep any stock of this class of goods. We guarantee that all our Cycles, Frames, Motor Cycles, etc., as specified in our Price Lists, are made with best British Fittings throughout.

We have made a reputation for ourselves on account of the high quality of our products, and the low competitive prices which our extensive production and organisation permits us to charge. Among our customers are numbered the largest and most important buyers of Cycles and Frames in the country.

"CHEAP CYCLES."

We wish to call your attention to the so-called cheap Cycles which a few unscrupulous manufacturers have put on to the market. These Cycles and frames are built with dented and split reject tubing; with lug, crown and bracket castings which are cracked and can be bought at the price of scrap iron; cups, axles, pins and nuts of the worst quality imaginable, bought for next to nothing, and sometimes unplated; chain wheels and cranks, hubs, free-wheels, rins, chains, pedals, etc., of German origin, which, besides being of a very low grade, are of NON-standard sizes.

This is how our competitors turn out a Standard Cycle at a Popular Price.

Numerous complaints are being made in the Trade Papers about the quality of the materials used by a few firms who care little for their reputation. To the buyers of this class of goods it is not with regret that we say we cannot supply them.

CONDITIONS OF SALE.

PRICES.

I.—The prices of our goods are NETT, and they are for goods taken at our warehouses, Packing and CARRIAGE CHARGES etc. to be PAID BY CUSTOMERS, except in case of a SPECIAL QUOTATION FOR GOODS PACKING AND CARRIAGE FREE is given.

OUR TERMS OF PAYMENT AND DISCOUNT.

-Monthly Account Settlement 10th of each month Strictly Nett. Payment 7 days (from date of invoice) ... Discount 2½%. For Cash with Order We allow Special Spot cash Discount 5%. We will open a Ledger Account for prompt payment at 7 days from date of invoice with 2½% discount, or monthly account Nett, for any reputable firms placing regular orders with us.
Customers desiring a Ledger Account opened should furnish us with three trade references otherwise we deal only For Cash with Order.

CONSIGNMENTS.

3.—All orders sent carriage FORWARD or carriage PAID, travel at CUSTOMERS RISK. Our responsibility ceases when the goods are handed to carriers, and we are in possession of a signed receipt by one of the Companies' servants. PACKING ARRIVING IN BAD CONDITION, must be accepted when delivered, and signed for as damaged, or unexamined on Carriers' sheet, and claims for damage or loss should be made within 3 days of receipt of goods, to Carriers.

We are NOT RESPONSIBLE in any case for:

Loss of goods in transit.

Damage done to goods in transit, through Railway Co's fault, or through any other causes whatever, whether goods sent by Passenger Train, or by any other form of conveyance.

Delay in delivery of goods, through Railway Co's fault, or for any other causes. We can forward goods at Railway Co's risk, but then the charge is a little higher, but all accidents are at Company's responsibility. WHEN PLACING ORDERS PLEASE STATE IF GOODS ARE TO BE FORWARDED AT "OWNERS or COMPANIES RISK," without these instructions we despatch at owners risk.

CLAIMS.

4.—All claims, should mistakes occur, must be entered within 3 days of receipt of goods, and we will then replace gratis if needs, but any customer returning faulty goods, MUST PAY CARRIAGE BOTH WAYS. We do not accept responsibility in respect of any part, fitting, frame, or machine which has been built up, or ridden, or used. Any article bearing signs of use by customer cannot be the subject of a claim.

FORWARDING INSTRUCTIONS.

5.—We request all customers to LET US HAVE WITH EACH ORDER, INSTRUCTIONS as to how CONSIGNMENTS SHOULD BE SENT, otherwise, if no precise instructions are given, our warehousemen forward the packages the way they think best, but which does not always suit customers, in this case we must refuse any claim for extra expenses the consignment may cost.

EXPORT ORDERS.

6.—EXPORT ORDERS are executed at our prices and above Discount when placed by British Buying Houses or Merchants etc. or when a Banker's credit in England is opened with instructions to pay us ONE THIRD of the total value on account when placing order, and the balance against Shipping documents. We do not accept any Export orders without a cash advance, and the total of balance payable against sight draft in exchange for Shipping documents at Port of discharge.
