TRIVELOX GEARS, LTD. No. 128

Club-men, racing-men, and tourists alike have proved during the past few years that the Trivelox Three-Speed gear is ideal for all types of cycling. So popular has the system proved that no drastic alterations will be made for the 1937 season, but one or two minor changes will be executed. Among these will be the option of a single-wire control running over a pulley on the solo models to the cable cum casing control, and a new conversion plate. The latter is attached to the fork end itself, and enables the gear to be fitted to practically any make of machine.

A new two-speed edition of the famous gear will also be shown, which, having the advantage of a 4 3/8 in. width hub, enables it to be fitted to any existing bicycle, and will give a range of gears suitable for the tourist and racing man alike.

Safety spokes are being specially featured for use in conjunction with Trivelox hubs, and it is claimed that by the use of these spoke breakages may be kept down to a minimum.
