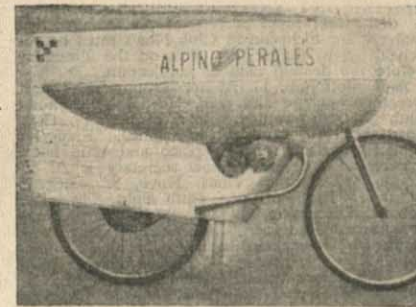

Two views of the 49 c.c. Alpiño Perales record-breaker

SUBJECT to the completion of certain formalities, Silver City Airways will start a Southend to Ostend air service at Easter. There will be four flights in both directions each week, at 9.00 a.m. and 4.00 p.m.

TWO world's records in Class 50 (Category A) were established on February 1 by Valfro Meo at the Aeropuerto Ministro Pistarini, Ezeira, Buenos Aires, Argentina. The machine was a 49 c.c. Alpiño Perales—really a cycle with an engine. The records were flying start kilometre at 57 m.p.h. (92 k.p.h.), and flying start mile at 56 m.p.h. (90 k.p.h.).
