Nedermotive moves to larger depot

Unprecedented demand for the Dutch Ankermatic, fuel-injected moped, which made its debut in the UK at Earls Court last month, by Nedermotive Agencies, of Hove, Sussex, has accelerated the concessionaires' move to larger office, store and warehouse premises.

As from Monday, October 16, Nedermotive will be at Anker House, 136 Albion Street, Southwick, Sussex. BN4 4AU (Southwick 3500). The new location comprises a 10,000 square foot building overlooking the yacht basin and close to the Holland Steamship Company, which ships the machines in from Holland and the Customs House.

Said David Startup, Nedermotive controller: "We were inundated with agency applications as a result of the Show; and even now, applications are coming in at the rate of three a day."
