Tyres for both cycles, motor cycles, and motor cars are on this stand in great variety, also air tubes. The Avon tyres for cycles have both beaded and wired edges. A solid motor tyre—the Coronation—is shown on a wheel. The Avon motor cycle tyres are heavy, extra strong, and medium A and B. Motor car tyre covers are grooved transversely, similar to the Dunlop, either round or square tread. Novelties include vulcanised repairs to motor covers and tubes, and the Lovelace patent non-slipping treads. The rubber used appears to be of excellent quality.
