

This interesting new lightweight motorcycle offered by Winsmith (Finchley), Ltd. is one of the few shaft-driven machines on the British market and the only lightweight so equipped. The 98 c.c. two-stroke Scott engine is based on the well-tried engine used on the autocycles. Forming an integral part of the power unit the two-speed foot change gear box fitted with a dry plate clutch is bolted directly to the engine. Current for ignition and lighting is supplied by a Wico-Pacy Genimag flywheel magneto. The rear wheel is quickly detachable leaving the shaft drive unit in position. Foot or hand operated starter are optional. There is plunger-type rear springing and telescopic front forks. The Scott Cyc-Auto is capable of over 40 m.p.h. and cruising at 30 m.p.h. will give 150 m.p.g. There are 4in. brakes, a centre stand and the rear mudguard is deeply valanced. Finish is in black enamel with silver tank and mudguards or with maroon tank and mudguards. Price £78 0s, 0d.
