

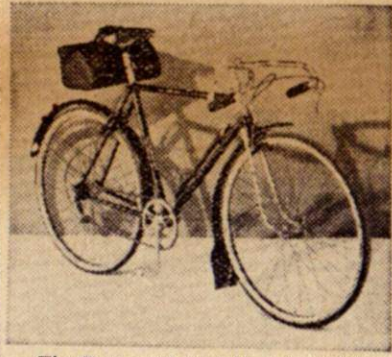

An attractive model, embodying such quality equipment as Bluemels guards and Brooks saddle, with all-chromium plated front forks, is the Speed Club at £6 2s. 6d., and considering the excellent specification of the machine, it is indeed splendid value. At £7 15s. is the Dawes

"Special," which can be obtained either in upright or normal frame design, and is a splendid piece of workmanship, while the highest-priced machine, the "Marathon," at 10 guineas, is as light and fast a job as one could wish to buy. Using the lightest of the excellent alternative specification, the weight of the machine is 23 lb.

The ladies are well catered for, and several attractive machines are at their disposal.

The "Good Companion" is the name of the higher-priced of the two excellent tandems to be shown, and includes the choice of several change-speed gears, hub brakes, large touring bag, and a built-in dynamo set. The Special tandem at £16 has also an excellent and dependable specification, and also includes a lighting set and touring bag among its many special features.
