A NEW three-speed model makes its appearance in the Dot-Vivi mo-ped range for 1960. In standard form, equipped

with a speedometer, it will sell at £69 19s. 3d. inclusive. A de-luxe version will cost £79 18s. 4d. and a de-luxe racer—replacing the two-speed racer—will be priced at £86 11s. The two de-luxe machines will shortly be available with kick starters and footrests instead of the normal pedals. The Dot-Vivi "Scooterette" is now a three-speeder and will cost £84 8s. 9d. inclusive.

Throughout the range the finish has been generally improved, and a new colour scheme incorporating black, cream, red and chromium is being employed. A full-length exhaust system with silencer takes the place of the small expansion box hitherto used. Other innovations are a luggage carrier and handlebars which are adjustable for height.
