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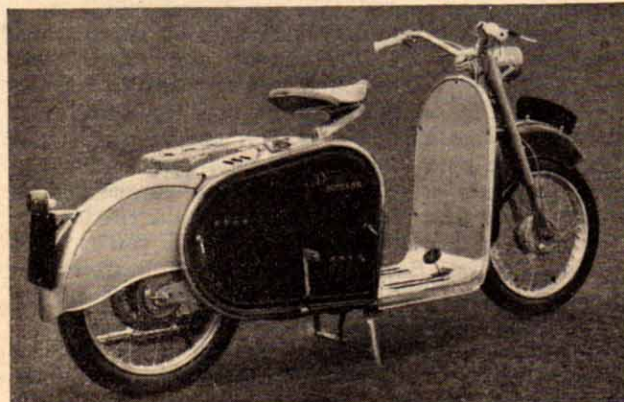

ANOTHER DUNKLEY SCOOTER

RETAILING at £77 11s. 1d. including P.T., the Dunkley "Popular" scooter, announced last week, is powered by a 49 c.c. o.h.v. engine in unit with a two-speed gearbox. It is unusual in not having rear-wheel suspension, but a substantial, cantilever-sprung saddle is fitted and front-end comfort is looked after by telescopic forks.

A variety of colour finishes is offered for this latest Dunkley, which, the makers point out, is made entirely at their works, Dunkley Motors, National Works, Bath Road, Hounslow, Middx.
