EXCELSIOR

THE appealing Excelsior range includes two 98 c.c. autocycles and five motor cycles—two 122 c.c. two-strokes, two 197 c.c. two-strokes and, finally, a 244 c.c. two-stroke twin. The autocycles are fitted with Excelsior engines, one has the Spryt and is a single-speeder on orthodox lines, while the other is fitted with the Goblin, which has a two-speed gear in unit. Apart from these differences, the two models, which are respectively known as the Autobyk S1 and the Autobyk G2, are similar; they have a sturdy frame and a front fork controlled by rubber rings.

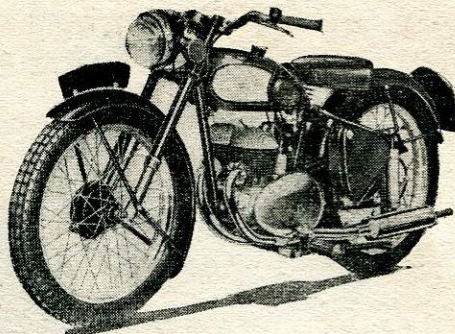
