OUR new Gazelle machines have recently been placed on the market, and are known as the "Open Road" range. A special folder illustrating the new models can be obtained from the Gazelle Cycle Company, Ltd., Nottingham. When writing, please mention THE BICYCLE. The first two are the Model P

and, its equivalent for ladies, the Model P.L. The frame of these machines is 21 in., and is completely brazed up, with fishtailed and cutaway lugs. Wheels are 26 in. x 14 in, with Endrick rims and rustless spokes. Dunlop Sprite tyres are fitted. Sturmey-Archer medium ratio (AM) three-speed is fitted as standard, while the front wheel has a Bayliss Wiley No. 9 special racing pattern hub. Caliper brakes. Brooks saddle, and super lightweight aluminium alloy mudguards are other features of the specification. Both gent's and ladies' models are priced at £7 7s.

The other two models are the Light Tourist Model R and the Light Tourist Model R.L., for gents. and ladies respectively, each costing £7 15s.
