
Perhaps the best moments of school are those spent outside of the classroom, chatting with friends when you arrive early.

To disengage the engine is simplicity itself. Simply press this button and pedal away. The Ciao instantly becomes a comfortable and smooth running bicycle.





The Ciao engine continues the Vespa tradition. It is a masterpiece of engineering, brilliantly designed and concealed. The Ciao presents itself with a personal style, a Vespa style which distinguishes it from every other two-wheeled machine.







The Ciao is available in two colour schemes. A two-tone grey or a two-tone dark blue and grey. In these illustrations can be seen the fitting for a pump and the two different solutions for the front suspension.

technical specifications

The Ciao uses a petrol-oil mixture, i.e. 2% oil.

Transmission from engine to rear wheel by means of an automatic clutch and trapezoidal shaped belt, fixed belt pulleys and reduction gear unit.

On the Model C9VI the engine transmission to the rear wheel incorporates an automatic centrifugal speed governor with expanding pulley, trapezoidal shaped belt, automatic clutch and reduction gear unit.

The Ciao is also provided with ancillary transmission composed of pedals, sprocket with crank, roller chain, free wheel sprocket, (ratio 28/18).


