NEW LOOK FOR RALEIGH RSW16 BICYCLE

A Mk. II version of Raleigh's big-selling RSW 16 small-wheeled bicycle is to be introduced at the Earls Court Show this month.

New features include a Sturmey - Archer combined three-speed gear and hub brake (the caliper front brake is retained) a new Sturmey-Archer Dynohub with 4.5W output and re-styled head and tail-lamps, a newly designed handlebar that can be adjusted for height by a built-in locking lever and an Ogle-designed saddle with full foam padding.

Styling changes have also been made to the mudguards which are now in square section steel. To retail at £32 0s 6d, the Mk. II RSW 16 is finished in a choice of calypso coffee with brown check bag and black cables, or tropic blue with oatmeal bag and silver cables. Another new bicycle to be introduced by Raleigh is the

Another new bicycle to be introduced by Raleigh is the BSA Bermuda, a light tourist model offered in 19½in, 21in and 23in men's or ladies' frames.

Finished in red, blue or blue and gold, specification comprises 26in Endrick wheels with Dunlop Champion white wall tyres, caliper brakes, spring mattress saddle, steel guards and large saddle bag. Single-speed three-speed or Sturmey-Archer Dynohub versions will be offered.
