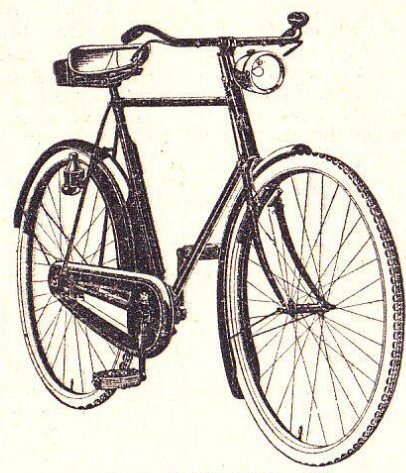

No. 58 is a ladies' model of ex-
ceptional value at £7 5s., with
three-speed hub and Rudge-Whit-

worth patented oilbath gearcase.
With internal expanding brakes
the price is £7 19s., and the model
can also be supplied with built-
in dynamo lighting set and bell
at an extra cost of one guinea.
Dunlop black sports tyres,
Brooks' saddle, adjustable North
Road handlebars, and a commodi-
ous kitbag, tools, oiler, and white
pump are all included in the
standard specification.

No. 78 is a roadster model sell-
ing at the low figure of £5 19s. 6d.,
with rim brakes and single gear;
£6 13s. 6d.; with internal expand-
ing brakes; £7 0s. 6d. with the
addition of S.A. 3-speed gear to
the original model; and £7 14s.
with three-speed gear and hub
brakes. The oilbath gearcase and
the Dunlop Roadster tyres make
this model ideal for "winter
wear."
