RUDGE-WHITWORTH DEVELOPMENTS

An announcement of interest recently appeared in the "Financial Times" to the effect that the Rudge Company were negotiating with the Electric and Musical Industries (makers of Marconi, Columbia, and H.M.V. radio and gramophones) for the manufacture of cycles at the works of the latter company.

These negotiations have been prompted, it is said, by the volume of orders received by Messrs. Rudge-Whitworth at the recent Cycle Show at Olympia proving too heavy to be handled at the company's works at Coventry.

No official statement, however, has so far been obtained from either company, although the Rudge vice-chairman admits that Rudge parts are already being produced extraneously. He stated that the plans and lay-out for a new twenty-acre Rudge factory, to be used in addition to the Crow-lane works, have been completed. Production in this factory, said the chairman, will be planned for increased quantities, and the most up-to-date methods and machinery will be installed. The question of site and of the actual buildings have not yet been settled.
