THE Cykelaid engine attachments for bicycles exhibited on this stand are already well known, but a brief description may be of interest. The set com-

prises engine, front wheel and spring forks, and can be fitted to almost any machine. The matter of fitting is extremely simple, as the transmission system is integral. The engine is a two-stroke with a bore and stroke of 55 mm. and 56 mm. and a cubic capacity of 133 c.c. The front wheel is driven through a cork inset clutch by a chain. This clutch is ordinarily withdrawn by means of a hand lever, but provision is made for its permanent withdrawal, so that the machine can be wheeled or pedalled, as in the case of an ordinary cycle. The Cykelaid set is exhibited on this stand as a complete machine for ladies, gentlemen, as a tandem, etc., and there is also a sectional working model of the power unit which is worthy of examination, since it shows the design in detail.
